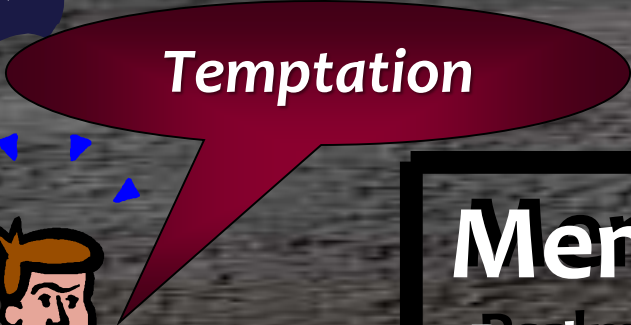
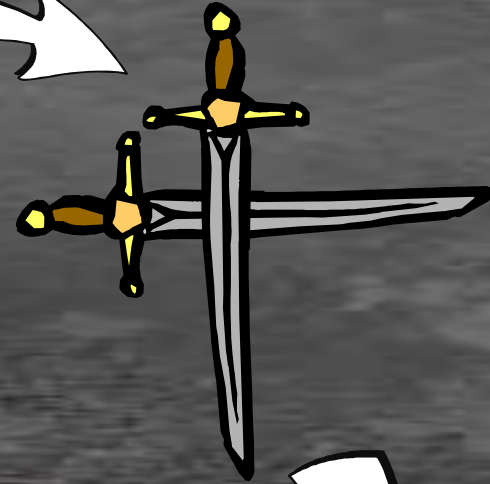
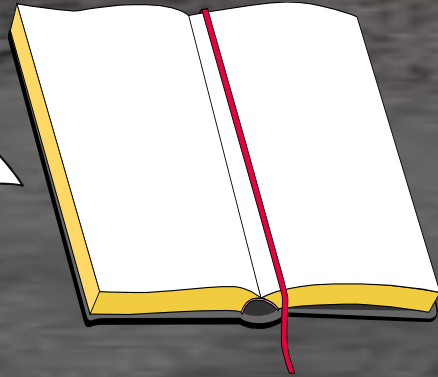

Lest you fall

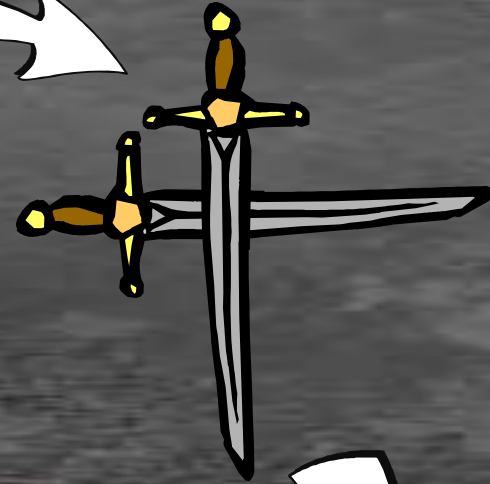
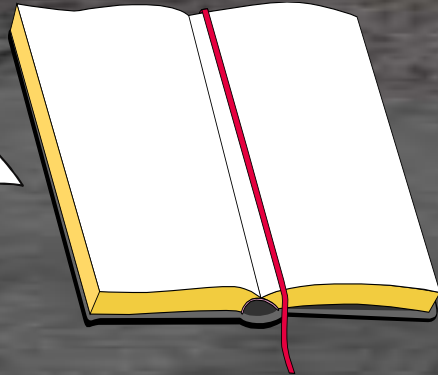
Don't be fooled by flattery (she really doesn't want you).

You can't beat this all by yourself.

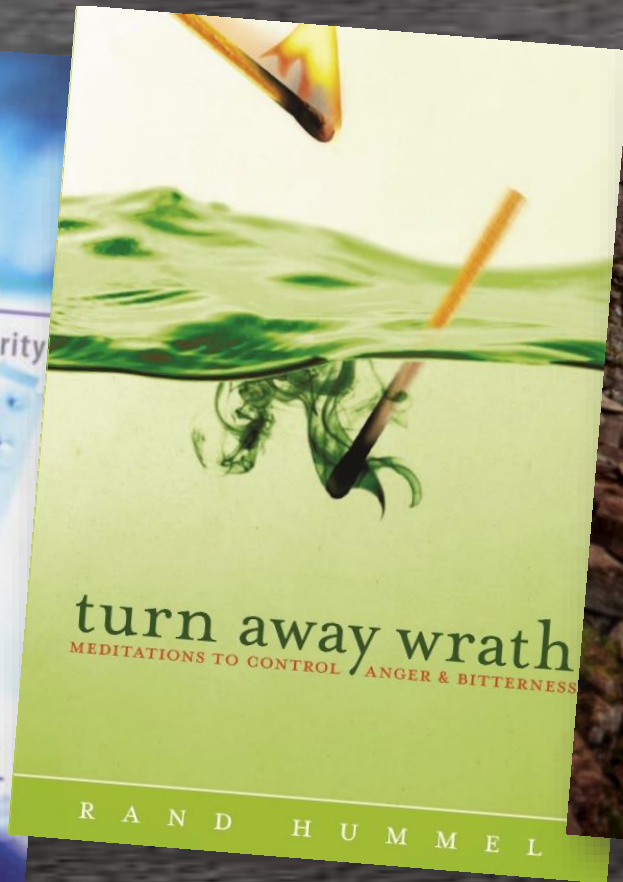
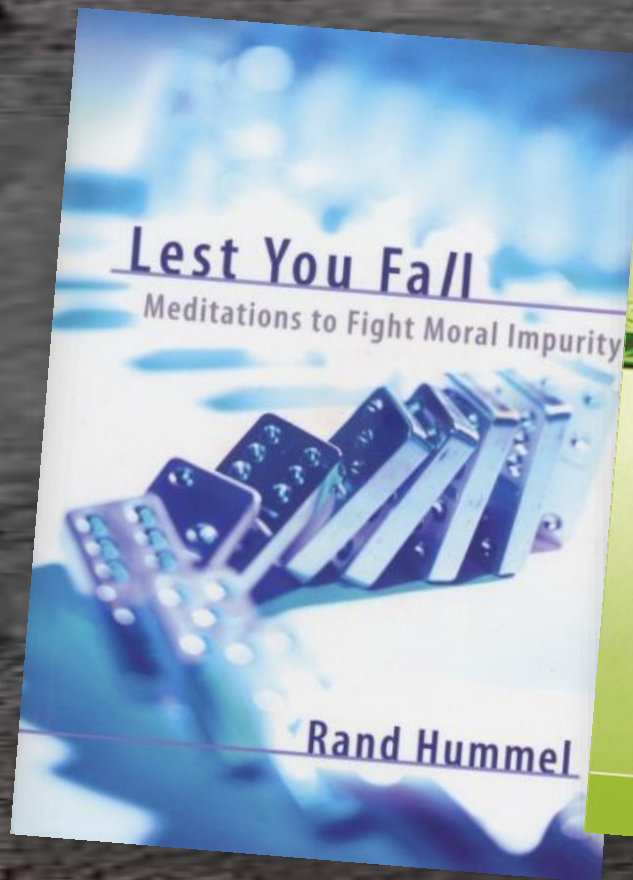
